The shelter report findings will be used by the ECs to formulate plans to effectively use these shelters. There was no new business for the club. For the club program, David KUOR gave a presentation of the IRARC Field Day 2012 with photographs and operating statistics. For the 50/50 drawing, John Webb, N3RCV won \$12.00. The meeting was adjourned at 8:30 PM.
