


Meet Us On the Following...

Red Cross Satellite Terminal Replacement

Operations of the Red Cross Satellite Terminal in Rockledge have been temporarily suspended. A new satellite terminal suite will be deployed to Red Cross centers including the Rockledge site sometime in 2013. IRARC had supported Red Cross Satellite Terminal operations with monthly tests of the Rockledge terminal until November 2012. The satellite terminals allows the deployed stations to have secure internet and voice over IP telephone service at a disaster location so the Red Cross can perform its relief missions. The existing terminal hardware was taken out of service and packed by IRARC members for collection at the Red Cross Orlando center. IRARC members will be requested to support operations after the new terminal hardware arrives and training is completed.
